POLICY: GREEN LIGHT POLICY

POLICY AND PROCEDURE HANDBOOK

POLICY: GREEN LIGHT

PURPOSE:

This policy establishes the guidelines for use of "GREEN LIGHTS" in personal vehicles responding to an emergency call when dispatched.

GUIDELINES:

1. A Volunteer firefighter may carry on or in a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or medical emergency.
2. No person other than a volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
3. Nothing in this policy shall be construed so as to permit a volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the Highway Traffic Act, the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, any other provincial legislation or regulation.
4. Appropriate firefighting gear **MUST** follow Beaver Emergency Services Commission SOGs and available in the volunteer firefighter vehicle.
