Beaver Emergency Services Commission Bylaw 13-2024

A BYLAW OF THE BEAVER EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMISSION FOR THE PROVISION OF BORROWING CAPACITY IN THE EVENT OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the Beaver Emergency Services Commission (hereafter referred to as BESC) recognizes that a major event in the BESC region will result in costs far exceeding the operational capacity of the organization.

Whereas, in the event of a large scale emergency there will be an emergent need to cash flow the supply of equipment, staff and various items.

The BESC Board duly enacts that:

- 1. The commission will arrange the financial borrowing capacity at Alberta Treasury Branch to a limit of \$500,000. This borrowing facility will inure from year to year ensuring timeless access when the State of Local Emergency is enacted.
- 2. The emergency line of credit will be paid off in the quarter following the conclusion of the State of Local Emergency by way of a special requisition using the formula in the Beaver Regional Partnership Shared Services Agreement.
- 3. It will only be used for expenses directly resulting from the enactment of a State of Local Emergency.
- 4. All sums borrowed will be subject to the interest negotiated at the time of establishing the borrowing facility and charged by the financial institution from time to time.
- All documents require for the securement of the loan will be provided to the Alberta Treasury Branch at their request.
- This bylaw comes into effect and will be duly enacted at time of the first and final reading.
