BYLAW No. 2-2011

BEING A BYLAW RESPECTING THE APPOINTMENT OF A BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND DESIGNATION OF THE CHAIR PERSON OF THE

BEAVER EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMISSION.

WHEREAS the Beaver Emergency Services Commission has been established by Alberta Regulation 581/2010, and

WHEREAS the first Board of Directors and Chairperson of the Beaver Emergency Services Commission was appointed through Ministerial Order L:023/10 in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 602.07(1) (a) of the *Municipal Government Act*, the Beaver Emergency Services Commission must pass a bylaw respecting the appointment of its Directors and the designation of its Chair, and

WHEREAS a bylaw passed under Section 602.07(1) (a) of the *Municipal Government Act*, must be approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs before coming into force, and

WHEREAS Bylaw No. 1-2011 was adopted and the Board wishes to repeal that bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Commission enacts the following:

1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. "Act" means Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c M-26;
- 1.2. "Board" means the Board of Directors of the Commission;
- 1.3. "Chair" means the chairperson of the Board;
- 1.4. "Commission" means the Beaver Emergency Services Commission;
- 1.5. "Director" means a person appointed to the Board of Directors of the Commission in accordance with the Bylaw;
- 1.6. "Alternate Director" means a person appointed in accordance with this bylaw who shall represent a member municipality in the absence of the appointed Director;
- 1.7. "Member" or "Members" means the member municipality as set out in the Regulation;
- 1.8. "Regulation" means Alberta Regulation No. 581/2010

2. REPEAL of BYLAW

2.1. Bylaw No. 1 -2011 is repealed and replaced by this Bylaw.

3. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- 3.1. The Board shall consist of seven (7) Directors that shall be appointed as follows:
- 3.1.1. one (1) Director, whom shall be an elected official, from each of the following municipalities Town of Tofield, Town of Viking, Village of Ryley and Village of Holden; and
- 3.1.2. three (3) Directors, whom shall be elected officials from Beaver County.

3.2. ALTERNATE DIRECTORS

- 3.2.1. one (1) Alternate Director whom shall be an elected official, from each of the following municipalities: Town of Tofield, Town of Viking, Village of Ryley, Village of Holden, and Beaver County.
- 3.3. The term of each Director shall be specified by the Member appointing that Director.
- 3.4. A Director term shall automatically terminate if that Director ceases to be a Councillor for that Member.
- 3.5. The Board shall appoint from amongst its Directors at its annual organizational meeting, a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman, who shall serve in these capacities until the end of the next successive organizational meeting of the Board.
- 3.6. A Director may serve in successive terms as the Commission's Chairman or Vice-Chairman.

4. AMENDMENTS

- 4.1. In accordance with section 191(2) of the Act, a bylaw to amend this bylaw does not come into force until the bylaw is passed:
- 4.1.1. By a majority of the Directors of the Board; and
- 4.1.2. Approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
- 4.2. This bylaw may be amended, from time to time, by the Board of the Commission upon fourteen days notice of the amendment.
