

Driving Company Vehicles Policy # FIR-004

Board Approved Motion #25-077 Date June 11, 2025 Replaces Policy n/a Review Cycle 3 years

Purpose

The Beaver Emergency Services Commission (BESC) company vehicle policy provides workers with guidelines for using a company vehicle. This policy applies to all workers who operate a company vehicle.

Definitions

Commuting means the drive between home and the workplace. Workplace includes incident scenes.

Company vehicle is any vehicle owned and insured by BESC and its intended use is for responding to emergency situations, transporting crew members or general BESC business.

Employee means an employee employed by BESC.

Firefighter means a person appointed to perform the duties of a firefighter.

Personal Use is any travel that is not for work-related purposes. This includes commuting. **Worker** means an employee or firefighter.

Procedure

To be eligible to operate a company vehicle a worker must

- Provide proof they have a valid driver's license for the class of vehicle they will operate
- Have a clean driving record
 - No more than 6 demerits in the last 5 years
 - No criminal code offences in the last 5 years.
- Workers must follow safe driving practices
