<b>Mutual Aid</b>	
Rates are as set by the mutual aid agreement with the requesting municipality.	
<b>Alarms</b>	
1st Alarm within a calendar year	\$0
2 <sup>nd</sup> Alarm within a calendar year	Personnel time – minimum 1 hour per member
Subsequent Alarms within a calendar year	\$630 per incident
<b>Alarms from Beaver Foundation Facilities</b>	
1 <sup>st</sup> Alarm within a calendar year	\$0
Subsequent Alarms within a calendar year	Firefighter time-minimum 1 hour per member
<b>Inspections/Investigations</b>	
Fire Code Inspections and Investigations performed by BESC	\$75.00 per hour plus kilometres, plus costs
Fire Code Inspections or Investigation Performed by outside agencies	Actual Cost
Occupancy Load certificates including building inspections	\$75 per hour plus kilometres
Required by Provincial Legislation	\$75 per hour plus kilometres and incidentals
<b>Fire Hydrant Flow Test</b>	\$100 per hour
<b>Personnel Only</b>	\$20 per hour per person
<b>Consumables (i.e. firefighting foam, absorbent material, etc.)</b>	at cost
